

## **Exam rules for exempted students According to Safety Net Policy in terms of COVID-19**

Students in Medicine from I and II year who have achieved 90 % from the maximum points for the winter semester of the academic year 2019-2020 will attend online exam in the form of a test in the summer regular exam session, which will include the material only from the second summer semester of the same academic year. The duration of the exam will be 20 minutes for 45 questions with maximum number of 45 points:

For the students from the first 15 with the highest result and who have presented an essay for the winter semester, the following terms for the Anatomy exam will be applied:

1. They will attend the same test with duration and content described above.
2. If they reach 60 % from the points of the test (Average 3.00), they will receive for the final exam the grade they were given for the presentation of their essay in the winter semester of the academic 2019-2020.
3. If they have lesser than the minimum of 60 % from the points of the exam test (Poor 2.00), they will receive poor mark for the whole exam.

For the students in Pharmacy exempted from Cytology, Histology and Embryology, the following terms will be applied:
