

**Rules for the exams in the summer regular session of academic year 2020/2021 in the Department of
Anatomy, Histology and Embryology**

1. The exams in the summer regular session of academic year 2020/2021 in the Department of Anatomy, Histology and Embryology will be conducted in-person in two stages – MCQ's test and written question (essay).

2. Cytology, Histology and Embryology exam:

- First year medical students who have 90% from the points of the Cytology colloquium and 90% from the points of the Histology colloquium during the semester, will be exempted from the MCQ's test on the **Cytology** section.
- Regardless of the exemption all students will write down a question (essay) from the conspectus from the section **Histology**.

3. Anatomy I and II parts exams:

- First and second year medical students who have 90% from the points of first and/or second semester will be exempted from the MCQ's test on the section for the respective semester.
- Regardless of the exemption all students will write down a question (essay) from the conspectus for **Anatomy** exam.

4. Anatomy exam for Pharmacy:

- Pharmacy students who have 80% from the points of the semester test in **Cytology and Histology**, will be exempted from the MCQ's test on the **Cytology and Histology** section.
- Pharmacy students who have 80% from the points of the semester test in **Locomotory system**, will be exempted from the MCQ's test on the **Locomotory system** section.
- Pharmacy students who have 70% from the points of the semester test in **Internal organs and Nervous system**, will be exempted from the MCQ's test on the **Internal organs and Nervous system** section.
- Regardless of the exemption all students will write down a question (essay) from the conspectus for **Internal organs and Nervous system** section.

The lists with the exempted students from 1st and 2nd semester will be uploaded in our website after the end of this semester.
