Essay topics for second-year dental students with 3rd semester exemption

1. Blood supply of head and face. Arteries, veins, lymphatics. Communications. Clinical importance.
2. Anatomic danger zones in cutaneous surgery of the head and neck.
3. Anatomy of the Head. Scalp. Extra and intracranial vein communications. Clinical correlations.
4. Oral cavity anatomy. Blood and nerve supply. Clinical correlations.
5. Muscles of facial expression. Regional anatomy. Clinical correlations
6. Facial nerve. Anatomical and surgical importance.
7. Neuroanatomy of the pain system and of the pathways that modulate pain from face.

The essays should be emailed to prof. Sivkov (st.sivkov@yahoo.com) until January 20th, 2017.

Students who have gained full exemption and have been exempted from the previous semesters will present their essays on 26.01.2017 at 10.00 am. at prof. Sivkov's office.

Students with exemption from practical and MCQ-test (score > 90%) will write a written paper with the other students on the first day of the exam.

Students with 3rd semester exemption and final exam on other semester/s will present the essay on the next day during the oral exam.
