

ANNOUNCEMENT

The Cytology, Histology and Embryology exam
will be held in two days in the following order:

① Students sit for exam in white coats, with the student book and the Practicum from the practical lessons in Cytology, Histology and Embryology!

! Mobile phones are not allowed during the exam!

DISCHARGE:

Cytology colloquium:

- **90%** - students exempt the Cytology section (practical and theoretical)

Total score points (Cytology + Histology points):

- **90%** - students exempt both practical and theoretical test: 126 points or more. They sit only for the essay part (one question from General histology of the Conspectus) and oral part of the final exam
- Students with less than 90% (< 126p.) sit for the practical test, MCQ test, essay part and oral exam of the final exam

First Day - 08.01.2019

I. Practical part

7.30 – REGISTRATION in the Department of Anatomy, histology and embryology

8.00 o'clock – Practical exam

- **Histology - 8 microscopic preparations and 4 electronograms**

Students, who manage 60% of the microscopic preparations and electronograms (respectively 7) are allowed to sit for the theoretical test.

- **Cytology - 2 microscopic preparations and 1 electronogram** – the minimum of Cytology part is 60% (respectively 2).

The practical exam once passed will be valid for all the subsequent exams !

II. Theoretical test – Auditorium complex – Auditorim hall IV

- **LONG TEST** - Test on the three sections (Cytology, Histology and Embryology) - questions of varying degrees of difficulty. Total points – 60 points. Students must complete 60% of the total points of the test (**36 points**).

– **SHORT TEST** - Students who have 90% of Cytology Colloquium, write test on Histology and Embryology. Total points – 40 points. Students must complete 60% of the total points of the test (**24 points**).

III. Written theoretical part

One question from General Histology of the conspectus.

Second Day – 09.01.2019

Oral exam.

The final evaluation of the exam is formed by 70% of the evaluation of the test and the written part and 30% from the current evaluation of the first semester.
