Evaluation System:

Grade 2.00 in **one** of the three semesters means that the student has to do 70% on final practical exam!

70% is 35 points /28 gross anatomy + 7 microscopic points/ are the necessary minimum to pass!

Grades from 3.00 to 6.00 during the whole anatomy course means that the student has to do 60% on final practical exam!

60% is 30 points /24 gross anatomy + 6 microscopic points/ are the necessary minimum to pass!

The students who exempted one of the semesters should not fill it in the paper!
